002		All		Te	All references to <i>administration records</i> need to be reviewed to determine what items in the Edition 3 model should be referenced. The attributes previously in Administration_Record have been split between Administered_Item and Registration_State.	None provided.	
003		All		Te	The Identification region in FCD 11179-3 edition 3 is significantly changed. Corresponding changes need to be made to 11179-6. In particular: 1) 'data identifier' is replaced by 'Scoped Identifier'; 2) in edition 2 a single data identifier was used to identify an Administered Item. In edition 3, one or more Scoped Identifiers identify an Identified Item. 3) Version identifiers in edition 3 are still associated with Administered_Item, which means an Identified Item may have a scoped identifier without having an associated version identifier.
